Penny Bradford, WSW Board President receives Proclamation from Wicomico County Council Member, Eugenie (Shanie) Shields As many of us know, October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month, which is widely recognized across the United States. In October, the Wicomico County Council and the Acting County Executive honored Women Supporting Women with a Proclamation declaring October as National Breast Cancer Awareness Month in Wicomico County and encouraging all women to learn about the risks of breast cancer, to talk with healthcare providers about breast cancer screenings, and to be screened with clinical breast examinations and mammograms. WSW is deeply thankful and grateful for this proclamation, as it endorses everything our organization stands for.

Oven-Roasted Brussel Sprouts

These brussels sprouts are an easy and delicious side to make with your Thanksgiving Dinner! This side is mild, and great for those on a bland diet.

Ingredients:

1 lb. brussels sprouts 2 tbsp olive oil 1/2 tsp black pepper 2/3 tsp salt

Instructions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees and place rimmed baking sheet in oven.
- 2. Cut stems off brussels sprouts and remove loose leaves.
- 3. Slice brussels sprouts in half (length wise) and place in bowl.
- 4. Add oil, salt, and pepper to bowl. Toss brussels sprouts.
- 5. Remove baking sheet from oven and pour brussels sprouts onto baking sheet.
- 6. Place in oven for 45 minutes until sprouts are soft and begin to brown.




