Orange Carrot & Ginger Smoothie

If you have a low appetite or mouth sores, this is a great recipe to add vitamins and nutrients into your diet. Not to mention the high amount of antioxidants from the vitamin C.

Ingredients:

- 1 small orange
- 1 medium carrot
- 1 small slice fresh ginger
- 1/2 tsp turmeric powder
- 1/4 tsp cinnamon powder
- 1/2 cup water



Directions:

- 1. Peel the orange and separate into wedges. Chop the carrot into pieces, or grate if you don't have a high powered blender.
- 2. Add the orange, carrot, ginger, turmeric, cinnamon and water to a blender cup. Blend until smooth
- 3. Serve straight away with an extra sprinkling of cinnamon powder if desired.



Medicare Must Now Cover Lymphedema Treatment Garments

Lymphedema is no stranger to many breast cancer survivors. The chronic disease causes swelling and inflamed tissue in the arms and legs, which can be quite painful. Doctors will typically prescribe compression garments to survivors with lymphedema, but these supplies can be costly to the patient. Now, Medicare will be covering lymphedema compression supplies under the Lymphedema Treatment Act. This was signed into federal law at the end of 2022, but just went into effect on January 1, 2024.
